

Wilcox Brown Perpetual Trophy 2018

Background

Since inception in 2002, the Wilcox Brown Perpetual Trophy is an award to recognise the achievements of not for profit organisations in the City of Bunbury. The Silver Salver (pictured above) is the focus of the annual award and community members are asked to nominate groups based on their activities over the past year, special initiatives, milestones and specific achievements.

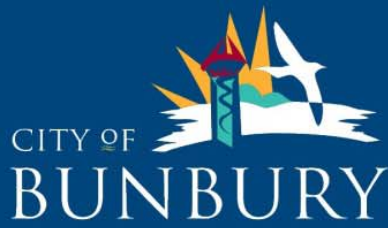
The presentation of the award is done by the Mayor on Australia Day as part of the City of Bunbury's Australia Day celebrations and the winner will receive the Wilcox Brown Trophy and a donation from Council of **\$1,500**.

It is intended that the award will:

- Recognise the contribution not for profit organisations make to community life.
- Enhance community spirit and pride.

Eligibility

- This award is open only to not for profit community based service organisations. This is not an award for individuals.
- Service clubs, sporting organisations, and not for profit environmental organisations are eligible.
- Groups need to have been operating for at least three years.
- Special initiatives, milestones and significant achievements will all be taken into account.
- There is no need for nominated organisations to be incorporated.
- The nominated group must be based in and primarily service the needs of the City of Bunbury community.
- Only groups that operate with an annual budget of under \$100,000 are eligible to be considered for the award (this amount to be reviewed every two years).

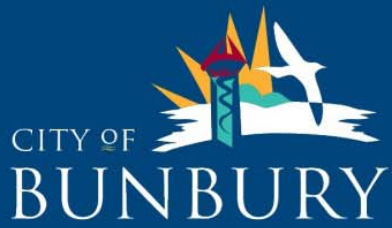

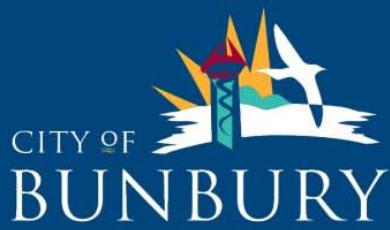
