Contemporary artist to deliver insight into latest exhibition

The Bunbury Regional Art Galleries is proud to present a new exhibition *Derek Kreckler: Accident and Process*.

This survey exhibition of one of Australia's most rigorous contemporary artists comes to the Galleries from the Perth Institute of Contemporary Art (PICA).

The exhibition features works across photography, video, installation, sound and performance. These works consider the relationship between culture and the environment, focusing on representations of landscape, national identity and the role of chance in determining these.

All are welcome to the exhibition opening on Friday 4 March from 6pm.

The artist himself will also be presenting a free artist talk on Saturday 5 March at 11am to give audiences some deeper insights into his works.

Also opening on Friday the 4 of March is *Sculpt* - a show featuring three-dimensional treasures from the City of Bunbury Art Collection.

Sculpt presents works by a variety of contemporary artists, exploring dreams, ideas, emotions and studies of light and space. The show also pays homage to the deep traditions of modelling, casting, carving and assembling which underpin contemporary practice.

Derek Kreckler: Accident and Process runs from Saturday 5 April to Sunday 10 April
Sculpt runs from Saturday 5 March to Sunday 1 May.
