## **#ShareTheSpot and be entertained!**

Bunbury's CBD will come to life on Saturday, 15 October with the relaunch of the City of Bunbury #ShareTheSpot busking locations.

The locations are dotted throughout the City and are permit-free to performers wishing to make a quick buck and entertain the masses.

Locations include:

- Bicentennial Square
- Guppy Park
- Market Square
- Jetty Baths
- Anzac Park
- Rocky Point
- Corner Elliott and Victoria Streets
- Bunbury Regional Art Gallery
- Bunbury Wildlife Park
- Corner Prinsep and Victoria Streets

It is hoped the relaunch will encourage more performers into the city whilst giving shoppers a chance to be entertained.

A recent call out to local performers will see nearly all locations filled from 11am to 3pm.

During the relaunch, visitors to Bunbury are encouraged to visit each location to check out the varied live performances. Performers range from an acoustic guitar set to flute-playing and one act featuring a Peruvian percussion instrument known as a Cajon.

Mayor Gary Brennan said the relaunch was to not only promote the #ShareTheSpot locations but to activate the City's streets and open spaces.

"Street entertainers add vibrancy and atmosphere to the city and the project is closely aligned with the goals and objectives of our Creative City Strategy," Mayor Brennan said.

"After the relaunch we hope it encourages local entertainers to take ownership of the project and continue to #ShareTheSpot with other performers."
