## **City looks at future options of CBD site**

The City of Bunbury will investigate possible future options for a slice of CBD land following the formal approach by Centrepoint Shopping Centre owners PrimeWest to purchase the Cornwall Street car park site.

CEO Andrew Brien will prepare a business case outlining all options, including not selling the land, and report back to the council in four to six weeks.

The land is currently used as a decked car park and is leased to PrimeWest long-term for around \$160,000 per annum.

Mayor Gary Brennan said the council had a responsibility to look at all options for the land.

“We are not saying that we are definitely selling this land, rather we are carrying out due diligence to ensure the City covers all contingencies,” Mr Brennan said.

“As with any sale of City land, if council does decide to proceed with the sale of this site then the proposal will be advertised for public comment.”
