More ways to pay rates online

The City of Bunbury is encouraging ratepayers to give letterboxes the flick and their inbox a tick by receiving rates notices online.

The City has introduced a new online service, MyPost Digital Mailbox, that enables residents to receive their rate notices securely online.

It is just another way the City of Bunbury is embracing new technologies to facilitate the rate-paying process.

The new online service offered via Australia Post complements other paperless rates notices including E-Rates and BPAY View.

MyPost Digital Mailbox also allows residents to set notifications and reminders to pay their accounts from any device with an internet connection to ensure they never miss a payment.

Ratepayers who don't subscribe to paperless rates notices will still receive their notices in the mail in mid-August.

Accounts can still be paid in person at the City of Bunbury administration centre, via credit card over the phone or by mail.
