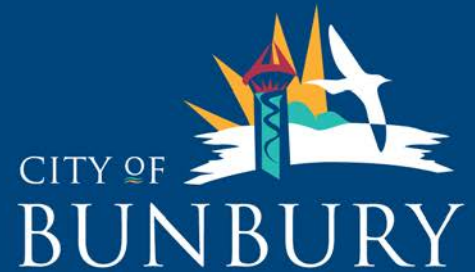

## **Hard and green waste collection service set to begin**

The next round of the City of Bunbury hard waste and green waste collection service will begin on the 10 October.

Hard waste is considered as furniture or whitegoods while green waste is considered as being tree and shrub prunings, lawn clippings and leaves.

For efficient collection of hard waste the City wishes to remind residents of the following:

- Maximum quantity is three cubic metres with items no longer than 1.5 metres;
- Metal must be separated from other materials; and
- Properties with more than three cubic metres of waste will not be collected and residents will need to make other arrangements for removal of the excess.

For efficient collection of green waste residents must ensure the following:

- Maximum of three cubic metres to be placed on the verge;
- Prunings or branches to be no longer than 1.5m and no greater than 200mm in diameter; and
- Prunings are in bundles with cut ends toward the street.

Residents are also warned not to place their hard or green waste on the verge for collection more than two weeks before the collection date and to ensure that their hard waste or green waste remains in a tidy state. A \$200 infringement can apply to waste being placed or left on verges outside of the designated area dates.

Electronic or hazardous waste must not be left for kerbside collection but can be dropped off at the City's Waste Operations Depot Monday to Friday between 7am to 3.30pm at 21 McCombe Road, Davenport.

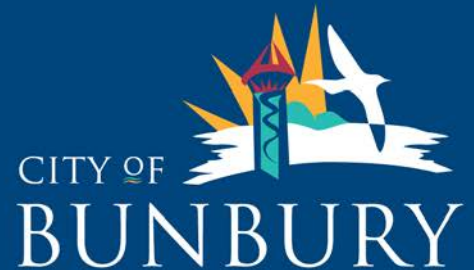
The depot accepts computers, printers, monitors, keyboards, televisions, DVD/VHS players, stereos/speakers, fax machines, game consoles, scanners, telephones, kitchen appliances and most electronic items including battery-operated devices.

- Hard waste to be collected on 24 October
- Green waste to be collected on 14 November
