BRAG bursts into bloom for much-loved exhibition

BRAG will explode with colour and aroma when the Blooming Art exhibition opens on Thursday 6 September.

This annual event takes over the Chapel Gallery with floral art thanks to the Bunbury Flower Designers Club.

One of BRAG's most popular exhibitions, the display is anticipated to draw more than 1000 people into the gallery over the four-day event.
